The DeLand High School Band is an extremely active, full-year co-curricular activity that depends on many resources to provide the finances necessary to provide students with a high quality and enjoyable music education in high school. Students are assessed financial obligations in specific areas described below to cover expenses that are incurred throughout the school year. These assessments only cover a portion of our actual expenses, but our goal is to keep these fees as low as possible. Although we ask that everyone contribute their fair share of these expenses as listed below, no student should ever feel discouraged from participating in band for monetary reasons.

Colorguard Fair Share Assessment - \$800

This assessment is paid by all members of the colorguard to help cover the cost of instruction by our expert staff members/clinicians, transportation, competition/FBA fees, music, show design, show shirts, practice tanks, costumes, props, winterguard floor, competitive circuit fees, entry into all competitions, tights, accessories, and much more. This is paid annually by all band members (instrumentalists and guard). This covers all fees and expenses related to marching band AND winterguard as colorguard is a FULL YEAR commitment and students must participate in both seasons.

Additional Expenses (to be paid as needed throughout the year)

- Guard Jacket - \$60 (estimated cost, one-time expense if kept nice)
- Marching Band Shoes (Prowlers) - \$45 (one-time expense if kept nice)
- Extra Marching Band Show or Spirit Shirt - \$15
- Extra Practice Tank - \$10
- Athletic knee pads (volleyball) - required, purchase on your own. These will help protect from injury when doing ground work outside and on the tile floor inside.
- Black Nikes sneakers with white check – required, purchase on your own (must be kept nice and only used for performances)
- Extra dance tights* and other undergarments – required, purchase on your own (will be specified) **one pair of performance tights will be provided for each season (marching & winter)*
- Make-up and hair accessories – required, purchase on your own (will be specified)
- Plain Black Leggings – required, purchase on your own for casual uniform, must be in school dress code
- Insulated Water Jug (at least half-gallon) – required for practice, purchase on your own
- Athletic Shoes – required for practice, purchase on your own

Payments

Assessments can be paid in full at the beginning of the year or in payments. All assessments must be paid off by December 1, 2026 to avoid being sent to the school obligations list. Further information regarding payment options can be found on the "Financial Responsibility Form."

Discounts

**Families may only choose one type of discount to receive.*

- *Early Pay Incentive* - If assessments are paid IN FULL (all assessments for the entire year) by the end of August, you will receive a \$50 discount.
- *Sibling discounts* (\$50 per sibling) are available for those with more than one child in the band.

How to Pay Your Assessments

Our preferred method of payment is electronic payment via Zelle to delandbpa@gmail.com. This is the safest and easiest way to make a payment. Please include your student's name in the memo line. Payments can also be made directly through CutTime for a small additional fee.

Payments may also be sent to school with students & placed in the payment band lockbox located by the band office. If sending payments to school, please place the payment in an envelope with your student's name on it and specify what type of payment is being submitted. Checks should be made payable to "DeLand BPA."
